Aviation Youth Camp Outline

This unique five day program will introduce youth, ages 13 to 16 to the incredible world of flight. The camp includes flight theory, airmanship, aircraft systems, meteorology and radio theory. The camp will run daily from 9am to 4pm, March 12th to the 16th, with early and late drop off available for an additional fee.

Introduction to Waterloo-Wellington Flight Centre

The Waterloo Wellington Flight Centre (WWFC) – located at the [Region of Waterloo International Airport](#)- is one of the largest and most experienced flight training centres in Canada. Originally founded as a flying club in 1932 and celebrating our 80th anniversary in 2012, we offer programs and services for individuals who enjoy flying as a hobby and those wanting to pursue aviation as a career.

We are partnered with Conestoga College and the University of Waterloo to offer diploma or degree programs in combination with a commercial pilot licence and multi-engine instrument rating. We also offer a Fast Track Professional Pilot program for students who already have a postsecondary education.

WWFC is registered as a Private Career College in Ontario and has a well developed network among entry level aviation employers across the country. Our fleet consists of 23 Cessna, Diamond and Piper aircraft, and ground training takes place in our 15,000 square foot flight school facility. We have 21 flight instructors on staff, all of whom bring lots of experience and 12 that hold a Class 1 or Class 2 rating.

Key Personnel

Our team consists of over 30 dedicated individuals to cover the various aspects of flight training and company operation. Our Communications & Special Events Coordinator – Maureen Dennie will be your AYC coordinator. Bob Connors is our General Manager and oversees all aspects of WWFC airport operations. Matt Scheben is our Chief Flight Instructor (CFI) and Peter Griffioen is our Director of Maintenance for our AMO. Michelle Forrest is our Dispatch Supervisor and plays a critical role in the smooth operation of daily flight operations, and Tammy Adams is our Post Secondary Program Coordinator.

All other staff work in support of the operating structure for WWFC and ensure that all services provided by the Flight Centre are able to meet the needs of our pilots, student pilots and visitors.

AVIATION YOUTH CAMP REGISTRATION

To register for the 2012 March Break Aviation Youth Camp with WWFC, please follow the guidelines listed below for efficient registration. Waterloo-Wellington Flight Centre shall ensure the safety of your child (ren) during the stated hours of the program. This includes all flights, classroom activities, and off-site tours within the boundaries of the Region of Waterloo International Airport (tour of ATC tower, Terminal, etc.). All youth attending the camp will be required to follow the guidelines and rules designed for their own safety and that of other participants and members. WWFC reserves the right to release participants from the program at the discretion of the Camp Coordinator and/or CFI should their behavior be considered disruptive or harmful to others, property or aircraft of WWFC. These guidelines will include a signed waiver form relieving Waterloo-Wellington Flight Centre of any injury or accident caused by neglect of these guidelines.

Register one of three ways

1. Mail in your child's completed registration form and payment.
2. Drop off your child's completed registration form and payment in person.
3. Fax in your child's completed registration form to WWFC at 519-648-3102.

Confirmation of your child's registration form will be sent out via email, along with a welcome letter and a "what to bring" list.

Cost: \$975.00 + HST (Includes flight training, supplies and lunch)

A \$100.00 deposit if required at the time of registration. The balance of the camp fee is due on or before Friday, February 24th, 2012.
