### Membership renewals

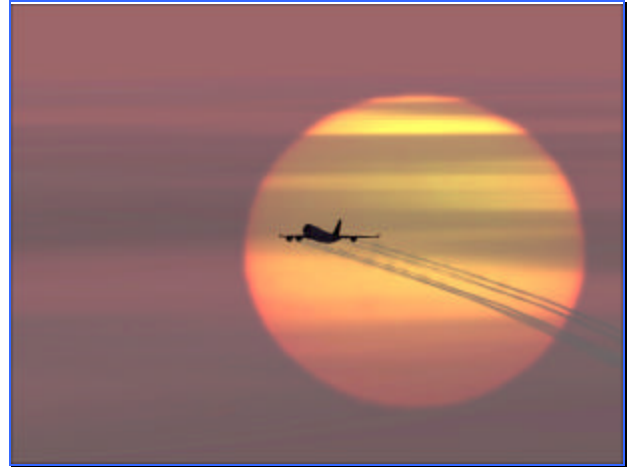
