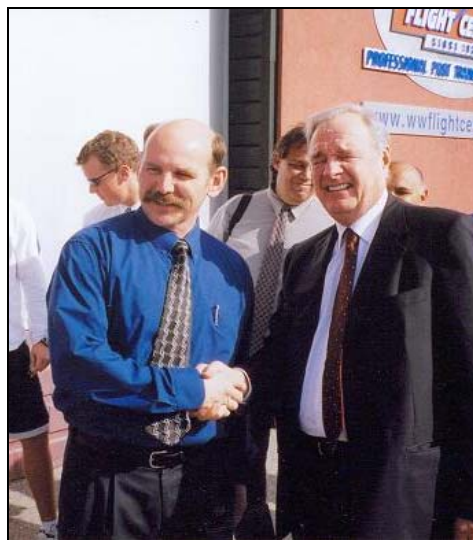
The open house is from 12 to 3 at the club... Current and previous members are cordially invited....
